Norm Fathers became involved with soccer because it could not be ignored, as the rest of the family were involved. His brother Jeff and sister Diane, together with sister in law Cheryl and wife Debbie all were involved.

Norm's main contribution was his expertise with figures and finance. He took on the role as treasurer with the Central Coast Women's Soccer Association (CCWSA) in 1984. He held the position for seven years until 1990. He received a Life membership from the CCWSA for his dedicated and professional services.

He was involved with the Central Coast Women's Representative Teams which participated in the NNSW State Titles. He was the Manager for the 1986 1st grade and went on to coach the NNSW State Youth team in the National Titles in 1992.

He was also active in the Wyoming Club and over a nine year period between 1984 and 1992. He was involved with the Women's 1st grade as manager, generally when his brother Jeff was the coach, and also coached several years 1988, 1989 and 1992. Every team he was involved with made the Finals and won one Premiership with two Runners Up.
