

Pat Moffitt 1935 – 2014

Life Member CCWSA 1992



Pat Moffitt was born in Wauchope on the NSW Mid North Coast in 1935. She moved to the Central Coast in 1957.

In 1968 she was the manager of her daughter's, Sue, netball team at the Adcock Park West Gosford complex. She remained there until 1975 when she had progressed to coaching.

In 1976 with the inaugural year of women's soccer on the Central Coast, Pat put her hand up to be on the organising committee. Sue was one of the first players to register and played for Brisbane Waters Club. She would progress to State selection at the peak of her career, and still plays today – 37 years later. One of the few inaugural Central

Coast players still playing.

Pat became Registrar of the newly formed Central Coast Women's Soccer Association and was involved, in some form or other, with the committee for the next 25 years. She had eleven years as Registrar 1977-1979, 1994-2001, four years as Rep Team Canteen Coordinator 1989-1992 and Secretary 1980.

Pat progressed to the committee of the Northern NSW Women's Association (NNSWWSA) as Registrar from 1977 to 1986 (10 years). She was honoured for her services by NNSWWSA with Life Membership.

Pat was also involved with the Central Coast Women's Representative teams in the capacity of Manager 1978-1982 (five years), 1995 (one year) and five years as a Manager for the Northern NSW Representative teams 1979-1983.

Pat was awarded Life Membership by CCWSA in 1992 for her outstanding service to the game. Pat Moffitt was an unassuming and loyal servant of the game. Her contribution was significant. She should be proud of the current state of the women's game, knowing that she was there at the beginning (1976).

Sadly Pat passed away on 4th May 2014.
